DON BOSCO COLLEGE, MANNUTHY ANTI-RAGGING POLICY (2026-27)

In compliance with UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 and Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1998.

Policy Statement

Don Bosco College, Mannuthy maintains a **zero-tolerance policy towards ragging** in any form. The College is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and dignified environment for all students. Ragging is a criminal offense and is completely prohibited within the campus, hostels, transport, and any College-related activity, including online platforms.

Definition of Ragging

As per UGC, ragging includes any act that causes or is likely to cause:

1. Physical or psychological harm, fear, or apprehension in any student
2. Verbal abuse, teasing, disorderly conduct affecting dignity of any student
3. Asking students to do acts they would not do ordinarily and which cause shame, embarrassment, or mental distress
4. Exploitation of juniors for completing academic tasks, financial extortion, or forced activity
5. Any act affecting mental health or self-confidence of a fresher or any student

Prohibited Activities - On Campus & Online

1. Forcing students to address seniors as 'Sir/Madam' or perform salutes
2. Forcing juniors to sing, dance, wear specific dress, or remove personal items
3. Any interaction between seniors and freshers without faculty presence during induction period
4. Cyber ragging: Harassment via WhatsApp, Instagram, SMS, calls, memes, or fake IDs

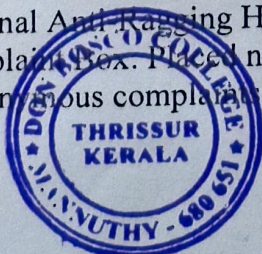
Procedure for Complaints

3. Committee must conduct inquiry within 7 days of complaint.

Punishments for Ragging

If found guilty, one or more of these apply as per UGC norms:

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
2. Withholding/deducting scholarship and other benefits
3. Debarring from appearing in exams or representing College in events
4. Suspension/expulsion from hostel
5. Rustication from institution for 1-4 semesters
6. Expulsion + FIR with Police → Imprisonment up to 2 years + fine up to ₹10,000 under Kerala Act
7. Mention of punishment in Migration/Character Certificate

Preventive Measures by College

Orientation- Separate induction for freshers

CCTV- Anti-ragging posters in all areas + CCTV in corridors.

Faculty mentors -Each fresher assigned a faculty mentor for first 3 months

Regular seminars by police/ counsellors on ragging consequences

Responsibilities of Staff

Staff - Any faculty who witnesses ragging and fails to report will face disciplinary action.
